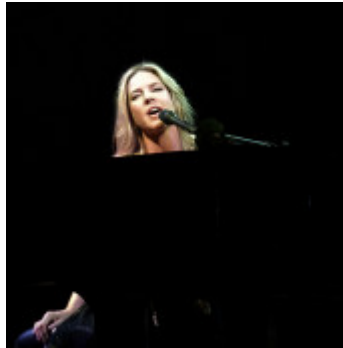


Diana Krall and the "discovery" Ola Onabule at Umbria Jazz 2016



Recently returned from a series of concerts in Australia and the Far East, she performed Saturday, July 9 at the Arena Santa Giuliana for the third time in recent years at Umbria Jazz singer / pianist Diana Krall. Diana Krall has sold over 6 million albums in the US and over 15 worldwide. As a singer, however, is the only jazz that has so far won three Grammy Awards and eight Juno Awards, awarded nine gold albums, three platinum and seven multi-platinum and making his debut, with nine of his albums, in topped the Billboard Jazz Albums. Despite the great success of his latest album, "Wallflower", released last March, the Krall on that occasion he did not want to promote the album, but propose different successes of revitalizing his career with that particular jazz touch that made it a ' artist beloved by the public, especially by the public of Umbria Jazz who met her in the early stages of his career. But the surprise of the evening was the debut of Ola Onabule, who opened the concert evening. London based Nigerian, eight achieved so far discs origins, his style ranges from music Yoruba Afrobeat, jazz, soul, and with lyrics that speak of an Africa with a thousand problems, but also from the boundless resources.
